The New Mexico Adult Education Association invites you to submit proposals for breakout sessions at their 41st Conference, October 22-24, 2009 in Ruidoso, New Mexico at the Inn of the Mountain Gods. The conference theme is **ABE: *Passport to Tomorrow's Opportunities***.

Your proposal should be based on one or more of the following criteria:

1. Relation to the Theme
2. Presenter Qualifications
3. Data Driven: plans to present evidence of improved student learning and performance or other outcome measures
4. Best Practices: through experience and research, a technique or method that has proven to reliably lead to a desired result
5. Innovative: innovation in a new method, synthesis of knowledge, or a successful implementation of a creative idea or technology

Each Proposal shall be categorized under the following topic categories for Director, Data Technician, GED Instruction, ESL Instruction, Student Leadership, Cadre (i.e. marketing, program & budget management, etc.), and Vendor tracks.

1. Transition to Higher Education/Training Workforce
2. Distance Education
3. Retention and Persistence
4. Data Quality – Analysis/Reporting
5. GED Instruction – all subjects – includes adult basic instruction (i.e. Curriculum Development, Teaching to a Multi-level Classroom, Essay Writing Made Fun, Addition to Geometry, etc.)
6. ESL Instruction (i.e. Curriculum Development, Facilitating Conversation for Adult Language Learners, Practical Lesson Ideas, Using Visuals and Music, etc.)
7. Accommodating the Multiple Intelligences/ Learning Styles
8. Student Leadership
9. Vendor

- ✓ All proposals must be submitted on the Call for Proposals Form (link below) **no later than August 28, 2009 by 5:00 p.m.** Proposals in other formats will not be considered. Presenters will be notified by September 11, 2009 if they have been chosen to present.
- ✓ Breakout sessions are either 50 minutes or 1 hour 40 minutes. We may be able to accommodate a very limited number of longer presentations. Please contact Shari Jobe if you need a longer session. Presenters should allow appropriate time for questions and answers from the participants.
- ✓ The Board welcomes panels of 2-3 presenters with at least one presenter who can share experiences from the field. Collaboration among organizations is encouraged.
- ✓ If the proposal is a panel presentation, please list all panelists on the Call for Proposals Form and indicate the Primary Session Presenter.
- ✓ Please indicate any AV needs on the Call for Proposals Form.
